Multi-functional the resource can be used by an independent learner at their work station or as a workshop resource delivered by presenters.

Interactive Ochre demonstrates "Educational Infotainment" as a methodology engaging learners in an interactive format across a range of media including animation, video, music/songs and interactive scenarios. The vibrant multi-media production delivers a holistic understanding of the plight of Australia's Indigenous people and is designed to assist both Indigenous and non - Indigenous workers. This workshop explains how infotainment can be used to develop engagement with learners and lead to understanding sensitive issues through interaction with content embedded in multimedia.

The resource has 5 sections each with detailed content documents, original music and interactive activities. This workshop will be of interest to industry, project developers, educators, RTOs and community groups wishing to use a cultural awareness course with a highly engaging methodology or find a means of addressing potentially sensitive issues.
